“With a Little Help From My Friends”

Parent volunteers are needed to help band camp run smoothly. Snacks and drinks are served during a break in the morning. In the evening Pop Ice and drinks are served. Parent volunteers are needed to donate snacks and to help serve during the breaks. Volunteers are also needed to help with the first aid station. “Good Morning Good Morning”

Band camp begins each morning at 9:00am sharp (on the field ready to go). Early is on time; on time is late. In case of bad weather, band camp will take place indoors and will not be canceled.

“I Should Have Known Better”

Band Camp participants are encouraged to bring the following to camp each day: Water Bottle; Hat; Sunglasses; Sun Block; Chap Stick; Weather Appropriate Dress; Comfortable Shoes (no flip-flops/open toed shoes/boots); Socks; Musical Instrument; Pencil; Lunch/Dinner (or money). While marching, students carry music and marching charts. A binder for this can be made using a lightweight 3-ring binder with shoelaces for the strap. Placing music/charts in sleeve protectors will keep papers from blowing out of the binders in strong wind.

“Roll Over Beethoven”

Summer sectionals will be held on Thursday evenings at 6:00pm (beginning June 24) for those students who wish to participate. Summer sectionals are not mandatory. Check the band website for times and dates.

“I Want to Tell You”

A1: Paul is out of step and barefoot. Please wear appropriate footwear to band camp and try to stay in step. Flip-flops/open toed shoes/boots and no socks will cause you **“A Hard Days Night”**.

A2: Gordy and Bradford wrote **“Money”**. Chuck Berry wrote **“Roll Over Beethoven”**. The Beatles performed both of these songs during their career.

Even though **“I’ve Got a Feeling”** **“Your Mother Should Know”**, here is advice **“From Me to You”** about **“Every Little Thing”**. Each day at camp will be a **“Long, Long, Long”** day and you will be marching **“Here, There, and Everywhere”**. **“The Night Before”** attending band camp, get plenty of rest. Eat breakfast in the morning. **“Nobody I Know”** would tell the band directors **“I’m So Tired”**, **“I’m Only Sleeping”**, **“I’m Down”**, **“I’ll Be On My Way”**, **“I’m a Loser”**, **“Don’t Bother Me”**, **“I’ll Cry Instead”**, **“It’s All Too Much”** or **“I Forgot to Remember to Forget”** **“Because”** they feel tired or hungry. A better answer is **“I Feel Fine”**, **“I Will”**! I **“Dig It”**! **“If You’ve Got Trouble”** **“Any Time at All”** ask a parent volunteer for **“Help!”**. Let’s work **“All Together Now”**. Remember, **“It’s Getting Better All the Time”**, and eventually **“All Things Must Pass”**. **“Think for Yourself”** about **“What Goes On”** and **“What You’re Doing”**, **“That Means a Lot”**, **“Hello, Goodbye”**. **DISCLAIMER:** The intent of this flyer was to inform, educate and entertain.
